Sheila Watt-Cloutier, Nobel Peace Prize nominee and citizen advocate on Arctic climate change, will speak on **Thursday, February 23 at 7:30 p.m. at St. Dunstan's Church. Her talk is entitled, "Everything is Connected: Environment, Economy, Foreign Policy, Sustainability, Human Rights and Leadership in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century."** This is sponsored by The Andrew's Initiative at the UNB. All are welcome and admission is free.

Based in Nunavut, Ms. Watt-Cloutier has served as the Canadian President and the International Chair of the Inuit Circumpolar Council, representing the 155,000 Inuit from Canada, Greenland, Alaska and Russia. Under her leadership, she and 62 fellow Inuit from Canada and Alaska launched the world's first international legal action on climate change, with a petition to the Inter-American Commission on Human Rights. An award-winning advocate, experienced in working with global decision makers for over a decade, Ms. Watt-Cloutier offers a new model for 21<sup>st</sup>-century leadership. She treats the issues of our day--the environment, the economy, foreign policy, global health, and sustainability--not as separate concerns, but as a deeply interconnected whole.
